Subject: Ending my Formal Relations with the Baltic Defence College

- Earlier this year I entered into a contract with the College to further develop and mentor the 2005 Higher Command Studies Course (HCSC).
- In May I accepted to take an informal role as your consultant in relations to College management issues – an involvement that I had previously rejected as improper.
- This change of mind, this acceptance, was a fundamental mistake on my behalf. It was - in its nature - in conflict with my purely faculty role in relation to the HCSC. It led to contradictions and deep, unnecessary misunderstandings because of our differences in background, personal style and expectations.
- 4. The events in relations to the consultancy made me realise that even if the HCSC is important for the future, on balance it is the best solution that I make a clean break, leaving you to consolidate the College as a Baltic owned and led institution without me in the building.
- I have done enough for Estonia, Latvia and Lithuania since 1990. Best for all that I end now.
